2012 highlights

- ▶ 302 million litres of potable water saved (or 30% savings)
 - reduction to our client's utility bills of \$600,000
- average water savings of 700,000 litres per **Commercial property**
 - average water savings of 1.6 million litres per multi-family residential property
 - ▶ nearly 600 clients
- average ROI of 1.5 years for commercial and multi-family residential properties
 - ▶ delivered **LEED NC** and **LEED EBOM Credits** to clients in **Calgary** and **Toronto** using Climate Controlled Irrigation with

our weather station network has expanded to include Red Deer and Scarborough we have **40 weather stations**


covering major urban municipalities from Vancouver to Montreal

- completed climate controlled irrigation for Calgary's 4 largest shopping malls
- ▶ 1.46 billion litres... total amount of water saved since the launch of ExactET

understanding waste

- timer-based irrigation wastes **up to 60%** in potable water
- a City of Calgary 2003 study reported that automated irrigation systems watered 4.5x above recommended levels that's 8 feet of water in a season
- timer-based scheduling is the reason for this waste and is also the simplest and easiest to fix

Factors Affecting Irrigation Efficiency

TIMER BASED


Watering based upon arbitrary pre-programmed schedule: typically 3x per week



CLIMATE CONTROLLED

Watering based on changing climatic conditions i.e. watering more often during hot, windy, dry periods and far less often during cool, overcast, wet periods.

how it works

Landscapes need water at changing rates based on weather conditions:

watering more during hot windy periods and less during cool overcast periods.

Climate Controlled irrigation monitors and uses weather data to do just that.

How It Works





Just 4 simple steps:

- 1 replace only your timer-based irrigation controller with our climate-based controller
- **2** activate the climate-based controller to ExactET's local weather network
- program the climate based controller to apply the correct amount of water for the site conditions (i.e. slope, soil type, root depth, shade, etc.)
- 4 monitor and report measurable water savings results
